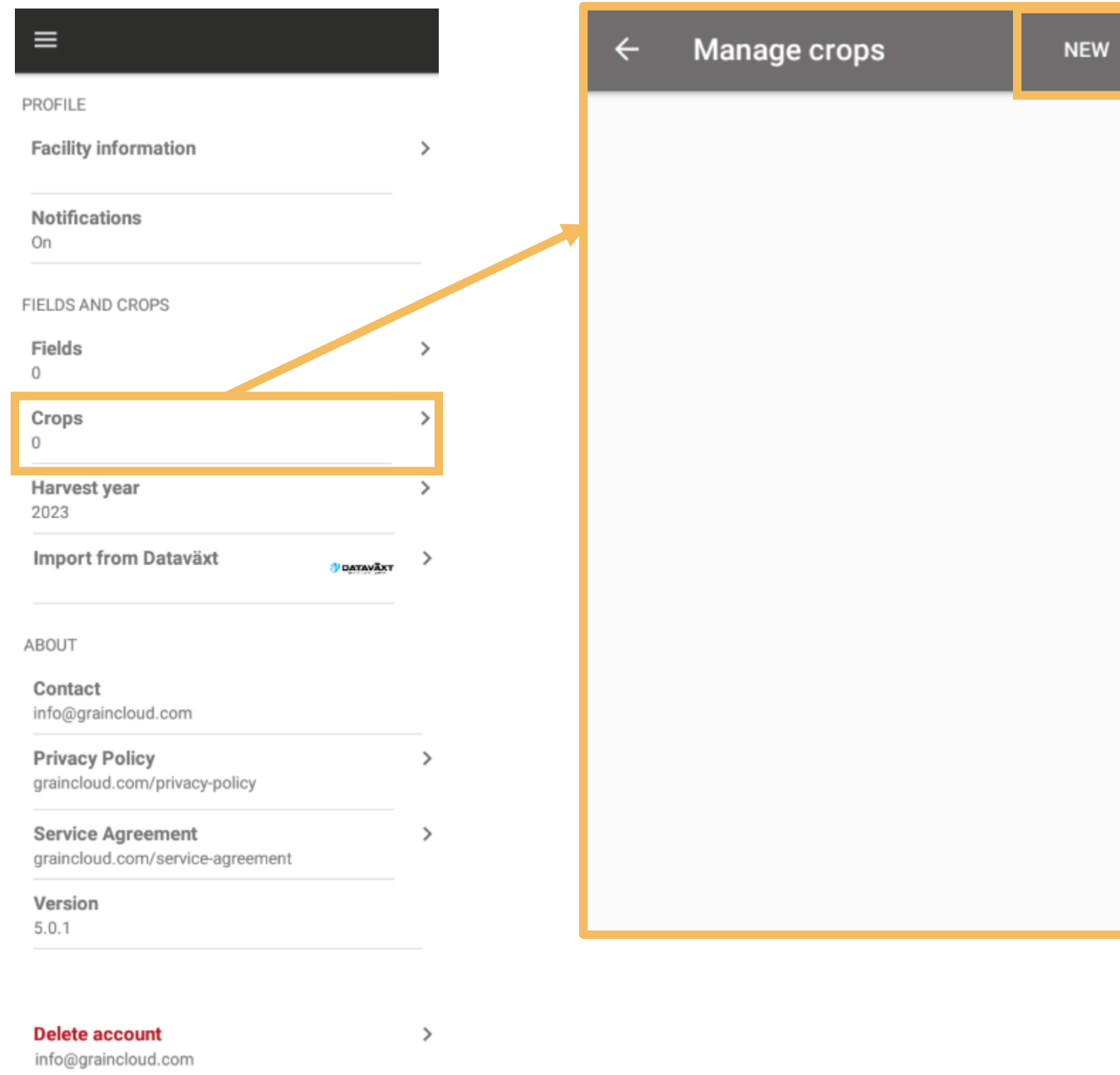

## INSTRUCTION

1. Click on Settings in Grain App.
2. Click on Crops.
3. Click on NEW.

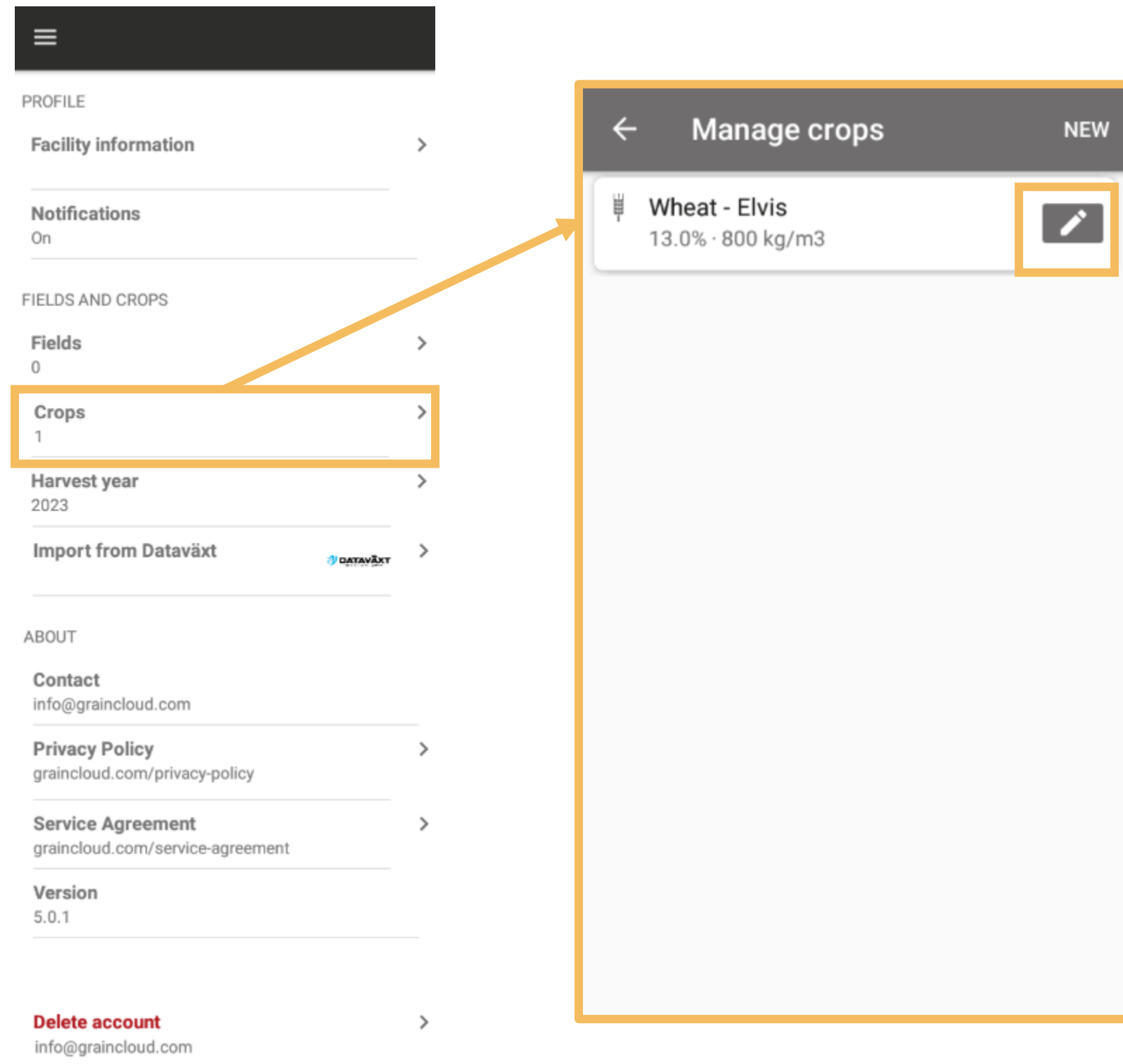
## INSTRUCTION

4. Fill in Crop.
5. Fill in Variety.
6. Tick preferred crop Icon.
7. Fill in Water content dry. This value is the target water content for the specific crop when dried. The value is used to calculate your dry inventory balance.
8. Fill in Volume weight.
9. Fill in Market value.
10. Click Save.

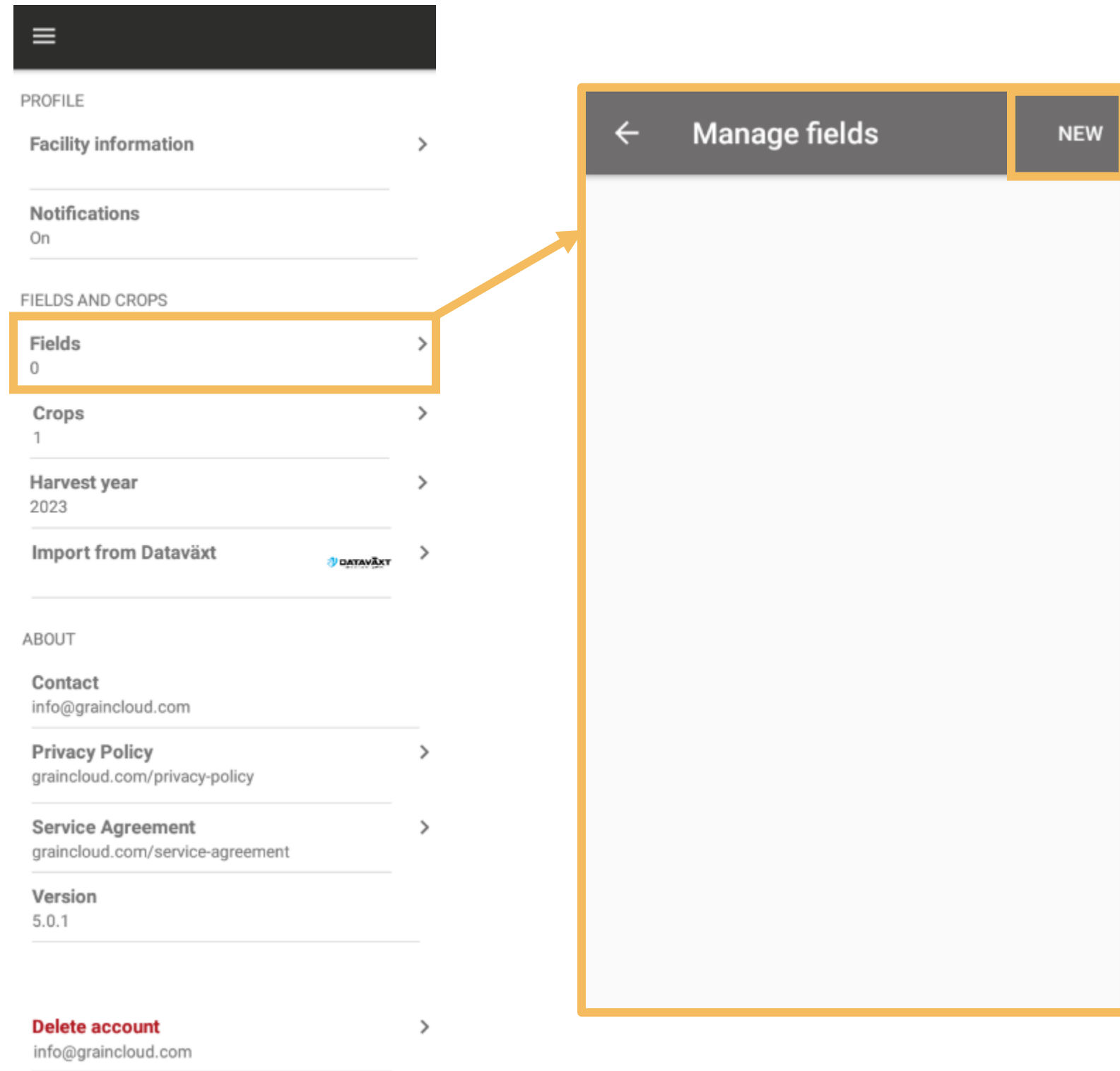
## INSTRUCTION

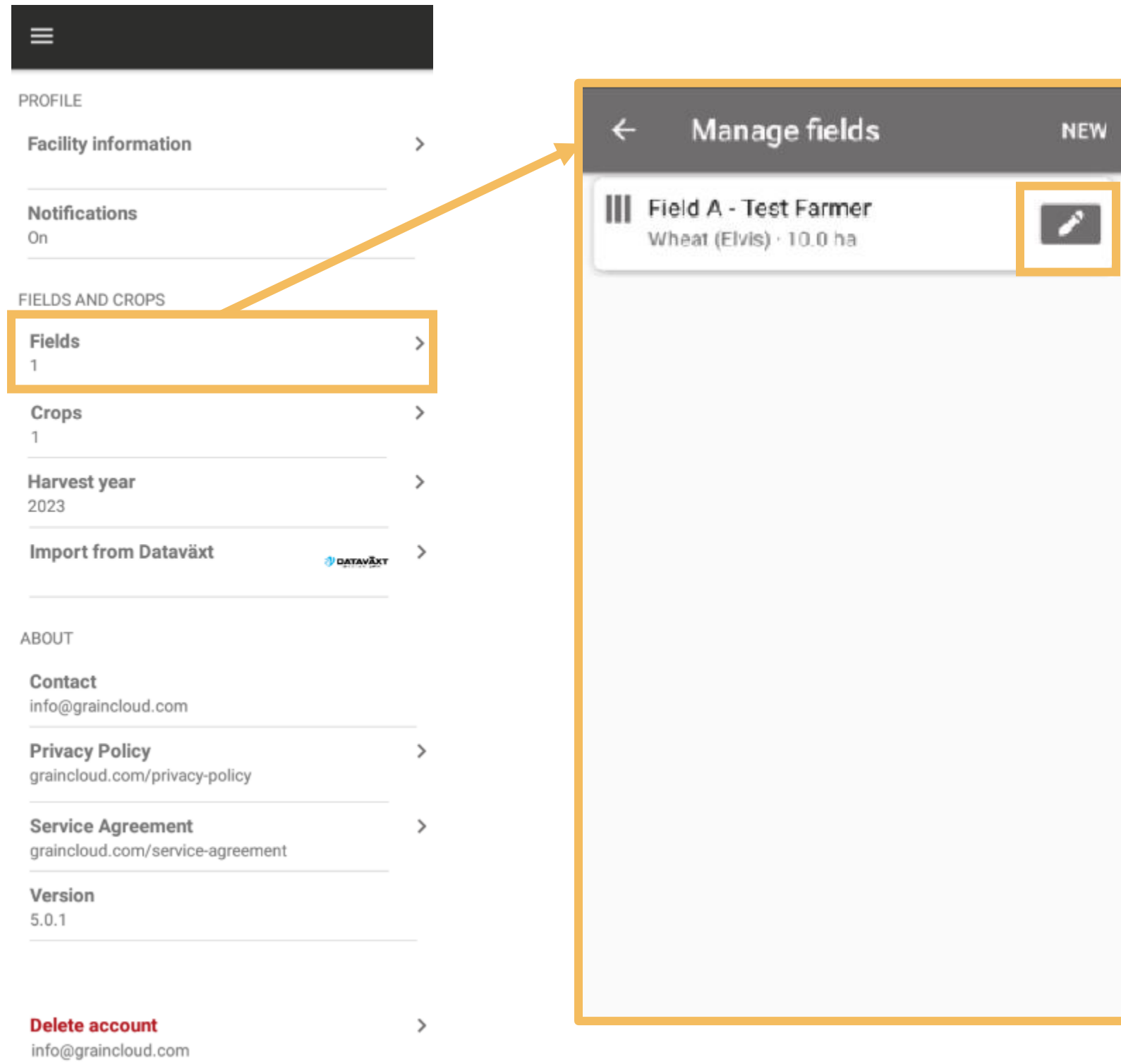
## INSTRUCTION

4. Fill in Name.
5. Fill in Owner. To be filled in, for example, if you are drying grain for someone else and then want to fill in their name, alternatively if you know that the grain in this field is to go to animal feed, you can enter this instead.
6. Fill in Acreage.
7. Click on the pencil icon to select which Crop is grown on the field.
8. Fill in Water content wet. This value is the expected wet water content of the specific crop on this field when harvested. The value is used to calculate your wet inventory balance.
9. Click Save.
